Animal of the jungle



The macaw is a type of **parrot** known for their bright feathers. When trained they can mimic words and learn tricks. They can live very long lives, living to 50 in the wild and up to 80 in captivity.



An **orangutan** is one of humankind's closest relatives. We share nearly 97% of the same DNA and the word orangutan comes from the Malay words "orang hutan", meaning "human of the forest".



In the butterfly world, the **blue morpho butterfly** is a giant. It is one of the largest species in the world, with an impressive wingspan of 5 to 8 inches. They are found in the jungles of Central and South America.



Mountain gorillas spend much of their time eating. Their food includes a variety of plants, along with a few insects and worms. Like humans they have 32 teeth and they will two sets, first baby teeth and then adult teeth.



The **green anaconda** is the largest snake in the world. It can reach a length of 30 feet. They don't kill prey through a bite. Instead, they wrap their bodies around their prey and squeeze until it stops breathing.

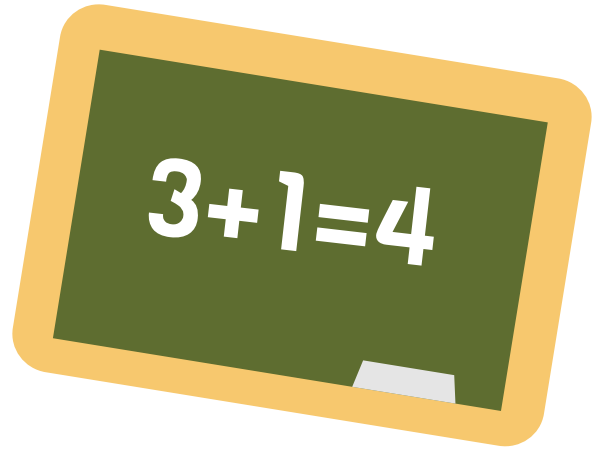
